25: **Scripture Reading and Message Discussion** Scripture Reading: 2 Timothy 2:14-19

Reflection Questions:

- 1. Is there a thought that stuck out to you, or spoke to you, from this week's message?
- 2. How do you understand the phrase in verse 15: "correctly handles the word of truth?" How is that similar or different to someone going ahead of you and 'clearing away the brush?'
- 3. How do you discern a 'correctly handled' teaching of scripture?
 - a. What do you think of John Stott's simple description of discernment: "We would be wise to ask ourselves regarding every kind of teaching...
 - What is its (the teachings) attitude toward God and
 - What effect it has upon others
 - "The truth always honors God (promotes godliness) and always edifies its hearers."
 - b. Is 'edification' always an 'encouraging' activity?
 - c. What about discerning by asking "how does this/does this lead me to Jesus?"
- 4. Is character/integrity a necessity in the life of those who guide and instruct others?
- 5. How is the use of words a way we participate in spiritual warfare?

Practice for the week: Be attentive to the alignment of your words with your heart (character and integrity).
